**DIRECTIONS:** The quantity of SURFACTANT to be used will depend on water hardness, type of foliage, spray material used, equipment used, and the degree of wetting or coverage desired.

In areas of soft water, use as little as ½ pint per 100 gallons.

In areas of hard water, use 1 pint of SURFACTANT per 100 gallons.

For larger mixes of pesticide spray solutions, add 1 gallon of SURFACTANT per 1000 gallons of solution, or follow the recommendations on the pesticide manufacturer's label.
